So, what are we up to? Well, TDot is not allowing meetings at this time and I suspect there are many of you out there who are not interested, for your own health, to attend a meeting, so no “formal” meeting for August. BUT...the board is going to get a room at Holy Spirit for an August 22nd meeting at 10:00 a.m. (we will let you know the exact room and how to get there later in the month). This will be for Itch to Stitch Skinny Quilt collection for the Tuscaloosa Juvenile Detention Center. Anyone who has a Skinny Quilt or a baby quilt (remembering that some of the girls in the Detention Center do come in pregnant), can drop them off at Holy Spirit. The Board will then arrange to drop them off at the center or meet Cathy W. somewhere so that we can drop them off since the Center is on lockdown as well right now. I want you to know that Ms. W. is soooooo excited about this because few people think to do anything for this center here in Tuscaloosa. She wants so desperately for us to be able to tour the facility and I promised her that we would love to do it when this is all behind us and we would also love to work with the kids that are out there like we had originally planned. It has made my heart swell with pride to know that we are doing this for them. So watch for the directions to the Holy Spirit room and if you need to, I told Ms. W. that we would probably have additional quilts come in later in the fall and would pass them on to her when they arrived.

We have not met since March and it does not look like we will be meeting the rest of this year. Kentuck has been canceled as many of you may already know, but there will be an online option and Becky B. and Linda W. will have more on that later in August. The Board has decided that since we have not met, we will carry forward all memberships from this year into next. We are not hurting for money and felt that it was only fair to all

the faithful members who have endured this year with the completely insane circumstances that we have had.

In September, we are looking to go back to Holy Spirit to have an outdoor garage sale of the fabrics and other items that have been donated to us. It will be a “cheap” garage sale with items going for small coinage.
