

WAQG 2020 QUILT ENTRY CATEGORIES

Hand Quilted: This category features hand quilting. Made and quilted by one person.

Hand Quilted Small. Up to 42" on any side

Hand Quilted Large. Greater than 42" on any side

Applique Quilts: Entries feature predominantly hand applique or machine applique.

Applique Small, Quilted on a Stationary Machine. Up to 60" on any side

Applique Large, Quilted on a Stationary Machine. Greater than 60" on any side

Applique Small, Quilted on a Movable Machine. Up to 60" on any side

Applique Large, Quilted on a Movable Machine. Greater than 60" on any side

Pieced Quilts: Entries feature predominantly piecing.

Pieced Small, Quilted on a Stationary Machine. Up to 60" on any side

Pieced Large, Quilted on a Stationary Machine. Greater than 60" on any side

Pieced Small, Quilted on a Movable Machine. Up to 60" on any side

Pieced Large, Quilted on a Movable Machine. Greater than 60" on any side

Wall Hangings: Entries are quilts intended to be displayed on a wall. Made using any technique.

Wall Hanging Small, Quilted on a Stationary Machine. Up to 42" on any side

Wall Hanging Large, Quilted on a Stationary Machine: Greater than 42" on any side

Wall Hanging Small, Quilted on a Movable Machine: Up to 42" on any side

Wall Hanging Large, Quilted on a Movable Machine: Greater than 42" on any side

Wall Pictorial:

Entries are quilts intended to be displayed on a wall. Quilts can depict any manner of subject matter, including people, places, plants, animals, etc. Entries must be made and quilted by one person. Any technique can be used, and quilts can be any size. Commercial patterns cannot be used in this category.

Special Techniques:

Entries in this category include whole cloth, crazy patch, cathedral window, yoyo quilts, and others. Quilts that emphasize embroidery, beading, wax batik dying, embellishment, photo transfer or other unique techniques can also be included in this category. They can be any size.

Non-Traditional:

Entries include quilted clothing and wearable accessories, table runners, kitchen or sewing room accessories, pillows, etc. Made and quilted by one person. Some part of these items must be quilted either by hand or machine.

Junior Quilters:

Entries include quilts or quilted items made by a person 18 years of age or younger. Quilted items can be any size. Any techniques can be used. Youth quilts may be critiqued by selected guild members, and earn participation ribbons. They will be separate from regular judged categories.

DEFINITIONS:

Quilted on a Stationary Machine: A quilting method that uses a sewing machine that sits on, or is mounted on, a table. The quilter moves the fabric when quilting, rather than the machine. A home sewing machine is often used for this quilting method.

Quilted on a Movable Machine: A quilting method that uses a machine that is mounted on a frame. The quilter moves the machine head rather than the fabric when quilting. A long arm machine is used for this quilting method.
